Key Responsibilities and Accountabilities

- Work with all related business units in both NEBC and Alberta to develop comprehensive Safety Management plans
- Collaborate with EH&S team to develop and maintain health and safety standards that reflect regulatory requirements, corporate standards and business leadership expectations
- Maintain high levels of workplace EHS visibility and engagement with day-to-day support as well as project work planning
- Lead Incident Investigation teams and investigation processes for high risk or major events
- Assist business representatives with investigations of medium to low risk events
- Attend Area Safety meetings and actively participate in work planning processes
- Provide input, based on site conditions and performance, to aid in the identification and development of EH&S processes, standards, policies, procedures, and work practices for the work site
- Monitor safety performance across the business areas, analyze trends, and support business management in the development of corrective action plans to improve performance to meet and exceed goals
- Assist with local support of project sites as required developing and promoting EHS initiatives and culture for construction, facilities and drilling/completion projects
- Support businesses with Emergency Management planning, testing and response
- Available on call as needed to support emergency response, incident investigations and ongoing operations
